- UWGCM funds 28 partner agencies who provide services to support health, education and financial stability to residents of Galveston County Mainland Communities.
- 866-468-2345 support services to 370 abused and neglected children.

- UWGCM's VITA program provided free tax services to 144 clients who received total federal refunds of \$192,345, including \$49,938 in Earned Income Credits.
- UWGCM sponsors two Student United Way Programs located at Clear Springs High School and Texas City High School. These two programs combined have over 200 active High School members who have donated more than 800 volunteer hours to our community.
- The UWGCM Training Program provides free training opportunities, ranging from job skills training to emotional wellness workshops. Over 25 trainings were conducted to more than 575 participants in the past year alone.
